

## CHB-NHLA FRENCH-LANGUAGE HARDWOOD LUMBER GRADING SHORT COURSE (Drummondville, QC) September 19 - 21, 2023

## **OVERVIEW**

The course will be conducted by NHLA Canadian Inspector Simon Laroque. The theoretical and practical portions of the course will be held at the Goodfellow Inc., in Drummondville, QC from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm approximately. Instruction is geared towards production, sales and office personnel, not necessarily to those directly involved in lumber grading. The goal is to make your personnel "rules conscious", not professional graders. The course will cover such things as a basic introduction to hardwood lumber grading, a basic rules description, lumber characteristics, cutting unit method, general instructions, standard grades, grading practice, lumber rule, species exceptions, net/gross tally etc.

## **REGISTRATION FEES**

Registration fees are \$300.00 per person, plus tax for members, and \$360.00 per person, plus tax for non-members. Rates include the qualified instructor and the required course printed materials. Participants should bring a notebook, pencils, boots and a lumber rule if possible.
