
Naturally green

We are home to 36% of certified forests globally, more than twice the area certified in any other country. Certification means our forests are managed to comprehensive environmental, social, and economic standards. Over 90% of our forests are on public lands and must be harvested at a sustainable rate and replanted by law. Canadian hardwood is recognized around the world as meeting and exceeding the strictest standards for sustainability and progressive management. Our forests are part of our heritage and our hardwood products are sought after by architects, designers and environmentally conscious consumers around the world.
